**Honjōzō-shu** *rice polished down to a minimum of 70%. fragrant + light-bodied.*

**Takatenjin ‘Sword of the Sun’ Tokubetsu Honjōzō** Shizuoka, Japan **300 ml | 52**  
delicate + light with elegant flavours of banana + melon.

**Hakkaisan Tokubetsu Honjōzō** Niigata, Japan **720 ml | 94**  
ultra clean + light, made with the pristine snowy waters that has made Niigata famous for the last decade.

**Junmai-shu** *rice can be milled to any percentage so long as it is listed on the label. full-bodied with pronounced acidity.*

**Izumi Junmai Muroka Nama Nama** Toronto, Canada **375 ml | 36**  
unpasteurized; fresh, bold + fruity with hints of nuttiness. Izumi means spring water in Japanese, referring to the fresh Huntsville water used to make it.

**Rihaku ‘Dance of Discovery’ Junmai** Shimane, Japan **300 ml | 48**  
herbal + earthy with banana bread aromas. made with a Shimane rice called Kannomai.

**Yoshi no Gawa ‘Kome Dake no Sake’ Junmai** Niigata, Japan **300 ml | 56**  
full bodied + clean, with notes of passion fruit + citrus. founded in 1548, Yoshi no Gawa is the oldest brewery in Niigata prefecture.

**Tōzai ‘Living Jewel’ Junmai** Kyōto, Japan **720 ml | 75**  
elegant, full-bodied, with white grape + delicate fennel notes. Living Jewel is the nickname given to the brightly coloured koi fish in Japan.

**Otokoyama ‘Man’s Mountain’ Tokubetsu Junmai** Hokkaido, Japan **500 ml | 80**  
very dry + subtle, with pronounced minerality. ‘tokubetsu’ means special, referring to the extra rice polished off the husk of each grain of rice.

**Dewazakura ‘Dewanosato’ Junmai** Yamagata, Japan **720 ml | 85**  
IWC 2016 winner. made with local dewanosato rice, this versatile sake has green apple + spice notes with a rich + soft palate.

**Tedorigawa Junmai Yamahai** Ishikawa, Japan **720 ml | 88**  
elegant yet packed with umami + subtle pear notes. made from Yoshida Shuzo, the subject of “The Birth of Sake” documentary.

**Yamatan Masamune “Tankan Wataribune” Tokubetsu Junmai** Ehime **720 ml | 92**  
a pleasant balance between fruit (apple, green banana + jack fruit) + the herbal backbone that come from using Wataribune rice.

**Ohyama ‘Tomizu’ Tokubetsu Junmai** Yamagata, Japan **720 ml | 96**  
full + savoury with notes of white grape, pear and fresh herbs.

**Sohomare Kimoto Tokubetsu Junmai** Tochigi, Japan **720 ml | 98**  
this award winning sake is made in the ancient Kimoto method from the 1600s. The sake has depth with herbal inflections, banana and umami..

**Ginjō-shu** *rice that has been milled down to 60% of its original size. elegant, refined + aromatic.*

**Kikusui ‘Fountain of Youth’ Junmai Ginjō** Niigata, Japan **300 ml | 42**  
melon + banana aromas with a smooth, round palate. It’s a perennial favourite!

**SakeOne ‘G’ Junmai Ginjō Genshu** Oregon, USA **750 ml | 80**  
big + bold! pear, melon + spice notes.

**Masumi ‘Karakuchi Ki-Ippon’ Junmai Ginjō** Nagano, Japan **720 ml | 96**  
clean, crisp + dry with green banana aromas. Masumi is the highest elevation brewery in all of Japan, located high up in the Japanese Alps.

**Dewazakura ‘Omachi’ Junmai Ginjō** Yamagata, Japan **720 ml | 100**  
layered + savoury notes of apple, melon and jack fruit laced with an herbal backbone.

**Yoshi no Gawa ‘Goku Jo’ Ginjō** Niigata, Japan **720 ml | 100**  
clean, light, dry, with orange peel + fennel notes. Niigata sake is reknowned for its tanrei karakuchi style - light, crisp + dry.

**Shichida Junmai Ginjō** Saga, Japan **720 ml | 105**  
elegant + mildly fruity with notes of apple, green melon + a clean finish. made with local, medium-hard water from Mt. Tenzan + Saga rice.

**Yuki no Bosha 'Limited Edition' Junmai Ginjō** Akita, Japan **720 ml | 110**  
banana candy + tropical fruit notes with a delicate, slightly sweet palate.

**Sharaku Junmai Ginjō** Fukushima, Japan **720 ml | 125**  
clean + crisp with refreshingly grippy notes of green pear, melon + jack fruit.

**Jikon 'Omachi' Junmai Ginjō** Mie, Japan **720 ml | 130**  
this rare gem is made with Omachi, one of the purest heirloom rice strains cultivated. it provides the sake with notes of grapefruit and vibrant herbal, spicy notes.

*Daiginjō-shu rice has been milled down to less than 50% of its original size. the pinnacle of the sake brewer's craft.*

**Hakutsuru 'Sho-Une' Junmai Daiginjō** Hyogo, Japan **300 ml | 42**  
crisp + bone dry with notes of apple, white peach + pear.

**Okunomatsu 'Sakura' Daiginjō** Fukushima, Japan **300 ml | 48**  
aromatic cherry + green fruit notes with an elegant, balanced palate on this perennial favourite!

**Higashiyama 'Pearls of Simplicity' Junmai Daiginjō** Kyoto, Japan **300 ml | 60**  
clean, complex with honeydew, licorice + lemon notes. made with Kyoto's famous Fushimi mizu (soft, pure water from the Fushimi ward).

**Kamoizumi 'Honjikomi' Junmai Daiginjō** Hiroshima, Japan **500 ml | 80**  
aromas of persimmons + melon following through on the palate with a clean, round finish.

**Dassai '23' Junmai Daiginjō** Yamaguchi, Japan **300 ml | 98**  
elegant palate with layers of tropical fruit + cucumber aromas. this cult sake is made using high quality Yamada Nishiki rice, polished down to 23% of its original size.

**SŌTŌ Junmai Daiginjō** Niigata, Japan **300 ml | 50 720 ml | 100**  
clean, crisp + dry with subtle hints of gala apple, lychee and cucumber notes.

**Niwa no Uguisu '50' Junmai Daiginjō** Fukuoka, Japan **720 ml | 105**  
fresh fuji apple + lychee profile to this sake, with a clean elegant palate that is extremely food friendly.

**Shirataki 'Jozen Mizuno Gotoshi' Junmai Daiginjō** Niigata, Japan **720 ml | 115**  
fresh apple, pear + honeydew melon with a very tight, clean + dry finish.

**Dassai '50' Junmai Daiginjō** Yamaguchi, Japan **720 ml | 130**  
complex + ultra clean with notes of mango + forest berries. the first sake in Japan to use centrifuge pressing, which attests to this sake's smooth taste.

**Taka 'Domaine Taka'** Yamaguchi, Japan **720 ml | 132**  
this sake explores the terroir of Taka's rice fields. It is a very unique bottling with elegance, soft aromas of honeydew and lychee fruit.

**Tatenokawa '50' Junmai Daiginjō** Yamagata, Japan **720 ml | 135**  
delicate floral + fruity characteristics intermingled with Yamagata's signature savoury qualities from using the local Dewasansan rice.

**Wakatake 'Demon Slayer' Junmai Daiginjō** Shizuoka, Japan **720 ml | 136**  
soft + easy going with ripe honeydew notes. the samurai's drink of choice.

**Kuheiji 2016 'Eau de Desir' Junmai Daiginjō** Aichi, Japan **720 ml | 148**  
grapefruit + fresh cut herbs. this is a cult brewery that grows its own rice and even owns a domaine in Burgundy, France.

**Hiroki Junmai Daiginjō** Fukushima, Japan **720 ml | 248**  
light + delicate with delicate aromas of white flowers, cantaloupe + apple. this is a tiny brewery that only makes small batch artisanal sake and very hard to find.

**Kokuryu 'Ryu' Junmai Daiginjō** Fukui, Japan **720 ml | 260**  
dry yet rich with subtle fruit aromas of pear, apple + red berry fruits. Ryu was the first to bring French wine maturation techniques to sake brewing.

**Hakkaisan 'Kongoshin' Junmai Daiginjō** Niigata, Japan **800 ml | 610**  
'kongoshin' means unwavering heart in Japanese. this extremely rare bottling is made with top quality yamada nishiki rice polished down to 40% and aged for more than two years at sub-zero temperatures to give it complexity.

**Nigori** *roughly filtered or 'cloudy'. textured and creamy on the palate, with flavours of coconut and tropical fruit.*

**Murai Family Nigori Genshu** Aomori, Japan **300 ml | 40**  
coconut + banana with spice and anise aromas. this is bold + richly textured!

**Kikusui 'Perfect Snow' Nigori** Niigata, Japan **300 ml | 45**  
bold + creamy with notes of banana, spice + steamed rice.

**Dassai '50' Junmai Daiginjō Nigori** Yamaguchi, Japan **300 ml | 55**  
a quintessential Daiginjō sake from one of Japan's cult breweries. melon, banana + Fuji apple lead to savoury jackfruit flavours on the palate.

**Momokawa 'Pearl' Junmai Ginjō Nigori Genshu** Oregon **300 ml | 30** **720 ml | 57**  
the piña colada of sake. notes of coconut, pineapple + banana.

**Sparkling Sake** *typically low alcohol + off dry.*

**Mio Sparkling Junmai** Nada, Japan **300 ml | 38**  
bright + fruity with a refreshing palate of cream soda + fresh stone fruit.

**Dewazakura 'Tobiroku' Sparkling Ginjō** Yamagata, Japan **300 ml | 45**  
crisp + dry with flavours of citrus, green apple + tropical fruits.

**Hakkaisan Sparkling Nigori Junmai** Niigata, Japan **360 ml | 62**  
cream, melon, strawberry + banana aromas

**Fruit Infused Sake**

**SakeOne 'Moonstone' Plum-Infused Junmai Ginjō** Oregon, USA **750 ml | 44**  
bold yet approachable fruit flavours combined perfectly with laced hints of citrus.

**Tsukasabotan Yama Yuzu Shibori** Kochi, Japan **720 ml | 85**  
lively citrus flavours with mandarin spice undertones from high quality yuzu fruit.

**Nanbu Bijin "Zen-Koji" Umeshu** Iwate, Japan **720 ml | 108**  
perfectly balanced tart-sweet component of fresh Japanese plums.

**Honkaku Shōchū Shōchū** is a Japanese distilled spirit that is typically distilled from barley (mugi), sweet potatoes (imo), buckwheat (soba), or rice (kome), but there are many other ingredients that can be used, like sake kasu, sesame seeds, chestnuts + shiso. Consequently, the profile will depend on the ingredients used. Shōchū can be enjoyed neat, on the rocks or heated and is also great in cocktails.

**Kuro Yokaichi Sweet Potato Shōchū** Kyoto Japan **1.5oz | 11**  
sharp, earthy + mellow. made with 63% Kyushu purple sweet potatoes + 37% rice.

**Tan-Taka-Tan Shiso Shōchū** Hokkaido Japan **1.5oz | 12**  
notes of green tea + shiso with a distinct, refreshing yet sweet palate. made using fresh picked purple shiso leaves from Hokkaido.

**Takahashi Shuzo "Hakutake Shiro" Rice Shōchū** Kumamoto Japan **1.5oz | 13**  
notes of banana + melon with a clean + fresh palate. The Hakutake is a "Kuma Shochu", a protected Geographical Indication (GI) from a small region in Kumamoto.

**Miyasaka Shuzo "Sumi 25" Kasutori Shōchū** Nagano Japan **1.5oz | 13**  
elegant and faintly reminiscent of sake. made from the lees (rice sediment) of freshly pressed sake. this is a rare find from one of Japan's most esteemed sake breweries.

**Komaki Jozo "Ikkomen" Sweet Potato Shōchū** Kagoshima Japan **1.5oz | 13**  
spicy + subtly sweet with savoury aromas of roasted sweet potatoes, pepper + cinnamon. distilled in small batches.

**Fushigiya Barley Shōchū** Oita Japan **1.5oz | 15**  
highlighting its toasted barley characteristics, the Fushigiya echoes the qualities and aromas found in whisky.

**Jinmatsu "Kokuto" Black Sugarcane Shōchū** Amami Islands Japan **1.5oz | 16**  
produced from the special black cane sugar from the legendary Amami Islands of Japan. aged in sherry casks resulting in a complex, deep + rich flavour.

**Kuroki Honten "100 Years of Solitude" Barley Shōchū** Miyazaki **1.5oz | 22**  
this rare shochu is matured for 3-5 years in oak barrels. the colour is amber and the shochu has great depth, complexity + a touch of oak seasoning.
